

Travel Information

By Air

The BIC can be easily accessed <u>Southhampton Airport</u> located just over an hour away from the BIC. Some airports may fly to Bournemouth Airport.

Bournemouth Airport

You can book a taxi directly from the airport through their recommended taxi service <u>PRC Streamline Taxis</u>. The taxi journey will be roughly 20 minutes traffic dependant and will cost approx. £20 – £25.00.

Alternatively you can catch an <u>Airport Bus</u> which will drop you near the BIC (7 minute walk). The journey time will be under one hour and the bus number is 737.

Southampton Airport

Has a direct rail link to Bournemouth, trains are operated on average four times per hour. For full train information please click <u>here.</u> The train will take you into Bournemouth Station and from there the BIC is only a short taxi ride away.

By Road

If you are following a sat nav please use BH2 5BH, this will take you to Exeter Road, this is the main entrance for the BIC, at the roundabout, take the first exit on to Priory Road then on to Beacon Road. The entrance for the conference is the Purbeck Entrance located on Beacon Road.



By Rail

London Waterloo is a mere 97 minutes away from Bournemouth. Fast daily train services also offer regular direct connections from around the UK and <u>Bournemouth Station</u> is approximately 1.5 miles from the BIC.
